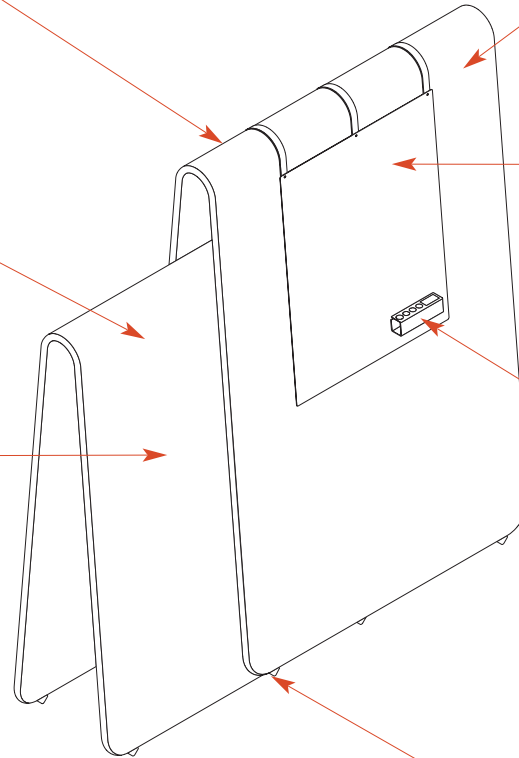
**A-Frame mobile screens** provide space division or create impromptu gathering spaces.

**Medium A-frame mobile screen** is 46"W x 57"H with a tackable fabric surface. Medium screen can nest inside a large screen for optimal storage when not in use.

**Screens** are available in two fabric selections:

- Blazer Lite Retreat (grade 2)
- Blazer Lite Solace (grade 2)

COM is not available.



**Large A-frame mobile screen** is 46"W x 71"H with a tackable fabric surface.

**Dual-sided, magnetic marker-board saddle**, specified separately, provides two 18-gauge metal, white writing surfaces, one for each side of the A-frame mobile screen. Three 10<sup>5</sup>/<sub>8</sub>"-long leather straps—available in Camel, Chestnut or Ebony—suspend the markerboard over the A-frame mobile screen.

**KORE™ magnetic marker/eraser holder**, specified separately, keeps markers and erasers close by. Holder accommodates four markers and one eraser.

**Four, non-locking casters** are standard on each mobile screen.

**IMPORTANT:** Expo dry-erase markers are recommended for use on markerboards. All other markers are not recommended, as they may leave undesirable results when erased.

**Suspension rods and panels** are both decorative and functional. Panel surface is tackable fabric.

**Suspension rods** are made of birch wood and available in a variety of finishes. They are available in three sizes.

**Acoustic Rating:**  
Suspension Panels and Rod  
NRC = .8

**Large (93"W) suspension rod** supports two or three suspension panels and comes standard with six leather straps.

**Pre-drilled pilot holes on front of suspension rod** are standard for attachment of rod to a wall. **IMPORTANT:** Selection and purchase of the proper attachment fasteners for the wall conditions is the responsibility of the installer.

**Medium (61"W) suspension rod** supports two suspension panels and comes standard with four leather straps.

**Suspension panels**, specified separately, are 29½"W x 19"H. Panels are available in four fabric selections:

- Cara Shetland (grade 1)
- Cara Merrick (grade 1)
- Blazer Lite Retreat (grade 2)
- Blazer Lite Solace (grade 2)

COM is not available.

**Small (30"W) suspension rod** supports one suspension panel and comes standard with two leather straps.

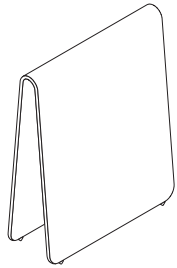
**Leather straps** are available in Camel, Chestnut or Ebony; they ship standard with the rod to suspend a suspension panel.
